

Arkansas ACTE Policymaker of the Year Award

Purpose

This award is presented annually by the Arkansas ACTE to recognize policymakers who have made a contribution of significance to Career and Technical Education in Arkansas.

Criteria and Eligibility

The award is presented to the individual or individuals who are determined to have made the most significant impact on policy related to career and technical education either during the past year or over an extended career of public service. (The award is not limited to one recipient for the Arkansas House of Representatives and one recipient for the Arkansas Senate.) The award is open to individuals having decision-making authority as evidenced by public or legal sanctions.

Application Procedures

Nominations may come from the Arkansas ACTE Board of Directors or from ACTE members; each nominee must be endorsed or sponsored by an association, agency, group, several individuals or a combination of these.

Groups nominating an individual for this award should submit a **cover letter stating the nominee's qualifications for the award and include supporting information listing significant legislative and other appropriate accomplishments related to career and technical education.**

Deadline

Nominations for the award will be accepted by Arkansas ACTE until **June 13**. The Legislative Committee and Board of Directors will select the award recipient (s) and the award will be presented at the Arkansas ACTE and Department of Workforce Education Professional Development Conference each year.
